4.	 Provide an attachment of names from the local community who will be involved in the project. Name of each individual (name, age and gender). Name of each clubs (cheldebechel) who are willing to be involved. 	
4.	 Provide an attachment of the itemized cost breakdown that sums up to \$5,000.00 grant budget. Expenses for construction materials such as bricks, gravel, rebar, cement, wires, etc., including expenses on equipment rental and road pavement are NOT allowable. Expenses for fuel, shovel, wheelbarrow, machete, chainsaw, and bush cutter, etc., are allowable. 	
5.	 You can add more than one registered historical site that sums up to the total grant budget. ➢ Only sites that are registered and listed in the Palau Register of Historic Places (attached) are eligible for this grant award. 	
6.	Provide an attachment of a recent picture from one of the selected registered historical sites that needs to be restored.
