





### Kokusai Communication Station Historical Site Tour

**Site Name: Kokusai Communication Station** 

Type: Japan Era/ Historic Remain

**Site Number:** 

The site contains historic remains dating to Japanese administration in an area referred to as Kokusai which is a Japanese word for communication station. The site is a savanna area from the southeast side of site B:NT-2:7 (Rois) and runs east encompassing the road from Kokusai to Nekken area to the west face of a ridge and turns south to the edge of the forest before turning west again. The main complex is located on a gentle slope on the east side of the Compact Road beside the road junction. The main complex includes concrete buildings, concrete foundations, toppled radio towers, scattered artifacts and part of the Japanese road

**Feature 1** is the main building in the Kokusai complex (Fig. 45, Photo 19). Located in the north portion of the complex (see Fig. 44), the concrete building is about 75 percent intact, with damage from Allied bombing at the end of WWII and general deterioration. The corner of the L-shaped building is on the southeast end, with a 15.5 m long and 6.0 m wide extension to the north and a 26.0 m long and 6.5 m wide extension to the west. The northern leg is one large room while the western leg is divided into four rooms. Three of the four western rooms are separated by concrete baulks that served as foundations for partitions. The easternmost room displays a partly intact concrete wall with a steel door. The westernmost room is a 5.0 m long room for four toilets and a simple shower stall. Doors and windows are in all the walls of the building.

**Feature 2** is a shell of a concrete building that housed the generator and the communication station. It had two doors with widths of 2.14 and heights of 2.60 with the southern door facing feature 1 and the other door facing north. The floor to ceiling has a height of 4m with windows along the east and west walls. Beside the west interior wall is a generator with a part of meter box for communication to the south wall. On the west and east exterior walls and above the windows are eves with small square ventilations above them. Running beside the west side of the building is another earthen berm that was probably a backfill material from the water reservoir



**Feature 3** is a rectangular water reservoir beside feature 2 to the west (Photo 24). In the middle of the feature is a round concrete feature with a round metal cork on top. The feature is still intact with water inside.



**Feature 5** is a circular depression located south of feature 3 with shallow water inside. This may have served as drainage for feature 3. Growing around it are euais (Hanguana malayana).
