Notice is hereby given that the **Director of the Bureau of Public Works** will be soliciting **sealed proposals** from interested Contractors, through the Capital Improvement Program Division (CIP) in Koror for the ROP-Economic Stimulus Package (ESP) FY-2024 (**Infrastructure Sector**), “**Design/Build of the M-DOCK BOATING FACILITY PROJECT PHASE-I.**” Statement of Qualifications and Project Cost Proposals will be accepted until **4:00 P.M. on February 14, 2025** at the CIP Office, BPW Building, Medalaih, Koror State. At the designated time and place, all proposals shall be reviewed and evaluated by authorized government personnel. Project Proposals shall be opened and used only by government personnel authorized to participate in the evaluation process until after the conclusion of negotiations and contract award to a contractor. A **Project Information Conference** will be held at the BPW Conference Room at **9:00 A.M. on January 15, 2025**. The detailed scope of the project will be handed over to prospective Offerors/Bidders at the start of the Project Information Conference.

The project was funded under the ROP Economic Stimulus Package (ESP) FY-2024 and shall be procured through a “Competitively Negotiated Contract” scheme as allowed under the Procurement Law.

Eligibility Criteria:

Based on grant conditions imposed by the granting agency/donor country, companies who intend to participate in the bidding process have to be:

- Wholly owned Palauan Construction Company; and/or
- Wholly owned Taiwanese Construction Company; and/or
- Joint Venture between wholly owned Palauan and Taiwanese Construction Companies; and/or
- Partnership between wholly owned Palauan and Taiwanese Construction Companies; and/or
- Wholly owned Palauan construction company subcontracting another wholly owned Palauan company or Taiwanese Company; and/or
- Wholly owned Taiwanese Construction Company subcontracting another Taiwanese company or wholly owned Palauan Company.

The government reserves the right to reject any or all proposals for any reason and to waive any defects in said bids if in its opinion would be in its best interest to do so.

Attendance to the Project Information Conference and Site Visit is mandatory for this project.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check, a cashier’s check or bidder’s bond made payable to the **National Treasury of the Republic of Palau** in the sum of **ten percent (10%)** of the aggregate proposal. The project will require **100% Performance Bond and 100% Payment Bond.**
